What is it?

As members of Swim Canada, the Blue Fish Swim Club is required to participate in Swim-A-Thon fundraising every swim season. Ninety percent of funds raised are allocated to our swim club. Funds are needed to ensure the viability of our program and allow our kids to reach their Regional and Provincial goals through participation in swim meets across the region.

What is our Goal?

Our goal this year is to reach \$10,000. We can do it! Previous years we have exceeded \$8,000. Each swimmer is required to fundraise \$300.00 each, in a ten week period.

When and Where?

Our Blue Fish Swimmers will be on deck on Wednesday May 25th, or Thursday May 26th from 3:30 until 5:30. Each swimmer will aim to complete 200 laps in under 2 hours for a total of 5 KM. This is not easy and deserves our full support!
